

1. Sponsorships are limited to 25 admissions per school year.
2. Sponsored students enter NIS in the term of or following public examinations in National Curriculum Year 6 or Year 9, such as UPSR and PT3. Sponsorship runs to the end of Year 11.

3. NRG Sponsorship is awarded to cover Tuition Fees, Application Fee (currently RM 1000), and Enrolment Fee (currently RM 2000) but not Boarding-related fees or deposits. In place of the Application Fee, NRG Sponsorship applicants are charged a non-refundable RM 100, to cover testing and administration costs. The Resource Fee, currently RM 850, must be paid each term.
4. NRG Sponsored Students pay a **reduced School Deposit of RM 2000**.
5. Nilai Resources Group expects sponsored students to complete a Cambridge IGCSE programme at NIS, showing loyalty and good faith. Full Terms & Conditions provided by Nilai Resources Group.
